

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids will be received by the Cuming County Clerk until July 13, 2021 at 11:00 a.m., for the mobilization, labor & equipment to install 5 spur dikes near the Elkhorn River west of Beemer. The bids will be presented to the Board of Supervisors on July 13, 2021 at a special meeting. The project is located near the Beemer Elkhorn River Bridge in Cuming County, Nebraska.

The project is referred to as “Cuming County Spur Dikes” and shall include all labor, transportation and equipment required for the installation of (5) spur dikes.
