## VETERANS BOARD MEETING FEBRUARY 28, 2022

### MINUTES

A meeting of the Veterans Board of Cuming County, in the State of Nebraska, was convened in open and public session at 7:32 a.m. on February 28, 2022, at West Point, Nebraska with Gatzemeyer, Feyerherm, Storm, Kindschuh, and Schwer present. Brahmer absent.

NEXT MEETING


