

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids will be received by the Cuming County Clerk until March 29, 2022, at 10:15 a.m., for the construction of one concrete deck slab bridge and other related incidental work. The bids will be presented to the Cuming County Board for consideration on March 29, 2022, at 10:30 a.m. and awarded on March 30, 2022, at 1:15 p.m. at its regularly scheduled meeting. The project is located on Road 1 between Road A and Road B in Cuming County, Nebraska.

The project is referred to as “Aloys Southwest, C-20(458)” and shall include all labor, materials, transportation and equipment required for the construction of a three span 102’-1” concrete deck slab bridge on a 0-degree skew with a 28 ft clear roadway, channel shaping, rock riprap, roadway grading and other related incidental work.

Copies of the Bid Documents and Specifications are open to public inspection at the office of the Cuming County Highway Superintendent, 200 South Lincoln Street, Room 202, West Point, Nebraska 68788. A set of documents may be obtained from Mainelli Wagner & Associates, Inc. 6920 Van Dorn Street, Suite “A”, Lincoln, NE 68506 (Phone:402-421-1717) for a non-refundable fee of \$30.00. All Bid Proposals must be submitted on the forms furnished with the Bid Documents.

The sealed bids may be mailed or delivered to the Cuming County Clerk, Cuming County Courthouse, 200 South Lincoln Street, Room 100, West Point, Nebraska 68788, and should be plainly marked as, “Construction Bid Proposal: Aloys Southwest, C-20(458)”.

Along with its Bid Proposal, each bidder shall submit an unconditional Bid Bond or Certified Check made payable to the Cuming County Treasurer, Cuming County, Nebraska, in an amount equal to five (5) percent of the total Bid Proposal. Also, each bidder is to provide a Start of Construction date and End of Construction date with its Bid Proposal. The desired completion date is October 31, 2022. The successful bidder (i.e. Contractor) will be allowed seventy-five (75) calendar days for completion after beginning work at the site. Additional days due to weather may be granted at the discretion of the engineer.

Within ten (10) days following the award of the Contract, the successful bidder shall furnish a surety bond or bonds in an amount equal to or greater than the full amount of the contract. The surety and form of the bonds are subject to the acceptance by the Cuming County Board of Supervisors.

Cuming County, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Dept of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally assisted programs of the Dept of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidden that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, sex, age and disability/handicap in consideration for award.

The Cuming County Board of Supervisors reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to waive any irregularities in bids received. Award of the Contract will be in accordance with the County Purchasing Act’s competitive bidding considerations as set forth in Neb.Rev.Stat. §§ 23-3110 to 23-3114.
