VETERANS BOARD MEETING APRIL 25, 2022

MINUTES

A meeting of the Veterans Board of Cuming County, in the State of Nebraska, was convened in open and public session at 7:33 a.m. on April 25, 2022, at West Point, Nebraska with Brahmer, Gatzemeyer, Feyerherm, Storm, and Schwer present. Kindschuh absent.
