<p>Proposition 1</p> <p>Shall the Village of Bancroft establish an economic development program as described here by appropriating annually one-half percent (0.5%) of a local option sales and use tax, estimated to generate approximately \$36,000 per year, for 10 years, for an estimated total of \$360,000?</p> <p>A vote YES will result in implementing the Economic Development Program.</p> <p>A vote NO will result in not implementing the Economic Development Program.</p> <p>YES (for the Proposition)</p> <p>NO (against the Proposition)</p> <p>Summary of Economic Development Program:</p> <p>i. Description of the Economic Development Program: The goals of the Program are to generate additional employment opportunities; retain and grow the local tax base; recruit new businesses; recruit and retain residents; retain and expand existing businesses; revitalize downtown central business district; and assist in housing development, including workforce and low- and</p>	<p>moderate-income housing. These goals will be achieved, in part, by establishing a grant and loan fund for use by qualified businesses and grant funding for public works improvements essential to qualifying businesses. The Program will be implemented and monitored in accordance with Nebraska's Local Option Municipal Economic Development Act.</p> <p>ii. Duration of the Program: The length of the Program shall be a period of approximately ten (10) years, from October 1, 2025 through January 31, 2035.</p> <p>iii. Years for Collection of Funds: Collection of funds for the Program shall be on all taxable sales beginning April 1, 2025 or as soon thereafter as provided by Nebraska Department of Revenue regulations, and ending January 1, 2035, provided, however, if bonds are issued and the local option sales and use tax revenue is pledged for payment of such bonds, the collection of funds shall terminate on the first day of the calendar quarter after payment of such bonds and refunding bonds.</p>	<p>iv. Source of Funds: The source of funds for the Program shall be a one-half percent (0.5%) of a sales and use tax imposed pursuant to the Local Option Revenue Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 77-27,142 through 77-27,148, as amended. Additional funds from other non-Village sources will not be sought beyond those derived from local sources of revenue.</p> <p>v. Issuance of Bonds: The Program includes a provision that proposes the Village issue bonds pursuant to Nebraska's Local Option Municipal Economic Development Act to provide funds to carry out the Program.</p> <p>vi. Total Amounts to be Collected from Local Sources of Revenue: The total amount to be collected from local sources of revenue is estimated to be \$36,000 each year for a period of ten (10) years, for an estimated total of \$360,000.</p> <p>Proposition 2</p> <p>Shall the governing body of the Village of Bancroft, for a period of 10 years, impose a local option sales and use tax</p>	<p>in the amount of one-half percent (0.5%) upon the same transactions within the Village on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax, with the proceeds of such tax being allocated to fund the Bancroft Economic Development Program?</p> <p>If a majority of votes cast upon such question shall be in favor of such tax, then the governing body of the Village of Bancroft, Nebraska, shall be empowered as provided by Neb. Rev. Stat. § 77-27,142 and shall proceed forthwith to impose a tax pursuant to the Local Option Revenue Act. If a majority of those voting on the question shall be opposed to such tax, then the governing body of the Village of Bancroft, Nebraska, shall not impose such tax.</p> <p>YES (for the Proposition)</p> <p>NO (against the Proposition)</p> <p>A vote YES will authorize one-half percent (0.5%) of Bancroft's local option sales and use tax to be used to fund the Bancroft Economic Development Program. A vote NO will not authorize one-half percent (0.5%) of Bancroft's local option sales and use tax to be used to fund the Bancroft Economic Development Program. A vote NO will also result in the Bancroft Economic Development Program not being implemented.</p>

<p>Summary of Local Option Tax:</p> <p>i. Reduction or Elimination of Other Taxes or Fees: The one-half percent (0.5%) local option sales and use tax will not reduce or eliminate other taxes or fees.</p> <p>ii. Projects to be Funded: The revenue collected will be used to fund the Bancroft Economic Development Program.</p> <p>iii. Duration of Tax: The tax will be effective for a period of approximately ten (10) years, beginning April 1, 2025 or as soon thereafter as provided by Nebraska Department of Revenue regulations, and ending January 1, 2035, provided, however, if bonds are issued pursuant to the Bancroft Economic Development Program and some or all of the local option revenue is pledged for payment of such bonds, the tax will be collected until the first day of the calendar quarter after the payment in full of such bonds and any refunding bonds.</p> <p>iv. Percentage of Revenue for Interlocal Purposes.
